**Notice concerning the Impact of the Typhoon (10<sup>th</sup>, named “Haishen”) in Kyushu Region**  
**(follow-up for previous notice)**

We would like to express our deepest condolences to all those affected by the typhoon “Haishen” in Kyushu region on September 6 and 7, 2020 and our wishes for the earliest possible recovery.

As a follow-up report for the notices on the Tokyo Stock Exchange’s TDnet, “Company Announcements Service”, and the website of Canadian Solar Infrastructure Fund, Inc. (“CSIF”), dated September 7, 2020, CSIF announces the current status of its power generation facilities in connection with the typhoon in the region.

According to Canadian Solar O&M Japan K.K. which is the O&M operator for the CSIF, CS Isa-shi Power Plant, CS Yusui-cho Power Plant and CS Isa-shi Dai-san Power Plant in that area which had been stopping generating electricity as at 12:00pm of September 7, 2020 have returned to their normal operations as at 12:00pm of September 8, 2020. Additionally, the CSIF’s PV power plants in the region suffered no material damages affecting their energy output from the typhoon as far as is known as at 12:00pm of September 8, 2020.

CSIF will continue to monitor and review its portfolio, and additional disclosure will be made should there be any material developments.
