Notice of donation to food support platform “WeSupport” for healthcare professionals

We express our deepest sympathy to those afflicted by the COVID-19 pandemic and pray for their speedy recovery.

We also express our heartfelt respect to all healthcare professionals on the frontline of this crisis treating patients day and night.

Takara Leben Infrastructure Fund, Inc. (the “Fund”) hereby announces that it made a donation to WeSupport, a platform jointly operated by General Incorporated Association RCF, Oisix ra daichi, and Coconet (Seino Holdings Group) for the purpose of delivering support in the form of food products free of charge to healthcare workers battling the COVID-19 pandemic. The details are as follows.

1. Background

Guided by a sustainability policy established on May 23, 2019, the Fund aims to concretely and proactively address ESG issues in its day-to-day business operations.

The lack of masks, protective clothing, and other supplies is a notable example of the concerns currently faced by frontline medical institutions, but the provision of health support to healthcare workers through stress management and diet is also important.

Many medical practitioners working every waking hour have said they are not getting enough to eat or that their meals lack nutritional balance. There are also fears of a deterioration in the food environment—for example, the suspension of late-night meal services—which could threaten the continuation of the healthcare system if such a situation persists.

In light of these circumstances, WeSupport was launched on April 20, 2020 for the purpose of playing a coordinating role in the distribution of supplies by matching information on food products sought by healthcare workers with companies and organizations ready to lend a hand.

These activities will not only aid the survival of the healthcare system that is currently confronted with a crisis situation, but they will most likely contribute to the following four of the United Nations’ 17 Sustainable Development Goals, or SDGs for short.

- ① Good health and well-being
- ② Sustainable cities and communities
- ③ Responsible consumption and production
- ④ Partnerships for the goals



The Fund is committed to supporting the aforementioned initiatives and therefore made a donation to WeSupport as part of its social contribution activities and in keeping with its sustainability policy. Going forward, the Fund will continue to undertake social contribution activities based on its sustainability policy.
