Ms. Yuko Abe acquired a wide range of experience and knowledge through her career successively holding key posts in Secretariat of the House of Representatives, including posts as the Director General of the Research Bureau and Deputy Secretary General of the Secretariat, as well as a post in which she took part in the formulation and implementation of labor policies at the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare. In the expectation that her insight will support the determination of important matters of the Company and supervision of the management as an Outside Director, we nominated her as a candidate for Outside Director. Although she has never been directly involved in corporate management, we consider, for the reasons mentioned above, that she will appropriately perform her duties as an Outside Director.

- Notes: 1. There is no special interest between each candidate and the Company.
 - 2. Among the candidates for Directors, Mr. Nobuhiko Takahashi, Mr. Yoshiro Masumoto and Ms. Yuko Abe are candidates for Outside Directors.
 - 3. If Mr. Yoshiro Masumoto's reelection and Ms. Yuko Abe's election are approved, the Company will designate them as Independent Officers as set forth by Tokyo Stock Exchange, Inc.
 - 4. Pursuant to the provisions of Article 427, Paragraph 1 of the Companies Act, the Articles of Incorporation of the Company stipulate that the Company may enter into an agreement with an Outside Director to limit his/her liability for damages arising from his/her negligence of duties. The maximum amount of the said liability for damages under the said agreement is the minimum amount of liability set forth in laws and regulations. If the reelections of Mr. Nobuhiko Takahashi and Mr. Yoshiro Masumoto and the election of Ms. Yuko Abe are approved, the Company plans to newly enter into the said liability limitation agreement with them.
 - 5. The Company plans to newly conclude a directors and officers (D&O) liability insurance policy with an insurance company as stipulated in Article 430-3, Paragraph 1 of the Companies Act. The insurance policy will cover damages that may arise from liability to be borne by the insured for his/her execution of duties, or from the receipt of a claim to pursue such liability. All the candidates for Director are to be included as insured parties under the insurance policy. The Company bears the total premium covering all of the insured. The Company plans to renew the insurance policy under the same conditions in effect at the time of renewal.
 - 6. With regard to attendance at the Board of Directors meetings, besides the Board of Directors meetings held as indicated above, there were two written resolutions whereby the resolutions of the Board of Directors were deemed to have been adopted pursuant to the provisions of Article 370 of the Companies Act and Article 25 of the Articles of Incorporation of the Company.

Proposal 2: Election of One (1) Auditor

Auditor Mr. Shunji Sato will resign at the conclusion of this meeting. Accordingly, the election of one Auditor is proposed.

Since a candidate for Auditor is to be elected as a substitute for the Auditor Mr. Shunji Sato, the term of office of the candidate upon election shall be the same as the remaining term of office of the retiring Auditor, pursuant to the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation of the Company.

In addition, the Board of Auditors has previously given its approval.

Reasons for nomination as a candidate for Auditor

Mr. Yoshio Hirabayashi engaged in administration departments for many years after joining e-License Inc. (currently the Company), has served as a General Manager of Internal Audit Office of the Company since 2018, and has accumulated rich operational experience and deep insight into the Company's overall businesses. We believe that he will observe and audit the execution of duties by Directors by taking advantage of his rich experience and wide-ranging insight. Therefore, we nominated him as a candidate for Auditor.

- Notes: 1. There is no special interest between the candidate and the Company.
 - 2. The Company plans to newly conclude a directors and officers (D&O) liability insurance policy with an insurance company as stipulated in Article 430-3, Paragraph 1 of the Companies Act. The insurance policy will cover damages that may arise from liability to be borne by the insured for his/her execution of duties, or from the receipt of a claim in pursuit of such liability. A candidate for Auditor is to be included as the insured under the insurance policy. The Company bears the total premium covering all of the insured. The Company plans to renew the insurance policy under the same conditions in effect at the time of renewal.
 - 3. Mr. Yoshio Hirabayashi is scheduled to assume the office of Auditor of MCJP Inc. and NexTone Systems Inc., two subsidiaries of the Company, upon approval at their respective annual general meetings of the shareholders to be held on June 11, 2021.

Proposal 3: Granting of Retirement Benefits to a Retiring Auditor

Auditor Mr. Shunji Sato will resign at the conclusion of this General Meeting of Shareholders. It is proposed that a certain amount of retirement benefits, which is determined within a reasonable range based on the prescribed criteria of the Company, be granted to him in appreciation of the service he rendered to the Company during his term of office. It is also proposed that the decisions as to the specific amount of the retirement benefits and the timing and method of payment be entrusted to the consultation of the Auditors.
