Advantest's outlook for the market environment anticipates that capacity expansion investments to solve the semiconductor supply shortage will continue for the time being, while demand for semiconductors will grow along with increasing end-product demand and higher functionality. Amidst the ongoing "digital revolution" and the push to improve energy efficiency, there is an increasing need for technology investments to achieve even higher semiconductor performance. Taking all of this together, Advantest expects the semiconductor and related markets to grow in the short and medium-to-long term.
