Notice of Revision to Dividend Forecast (Dividend Increase) for the Fiscal year ending March 31, 2023

NISSIN FOODS HOLDINGS CO., LTD. (hereinafter the “Company”) announces that the Company resolved to revise the forecast for its fiscal-year end dividend (Dividend Increase) at the Board of Directors held today as follows.

1. Reason for Revision to Dividend Forecast

The Company constantly endeavors to increase the Group's earning potential, recognizing growth in the corporate value and the provision of appropriate shareholder returns as the most important management priorities. Our basic policy is to provide continuous and stable returns to shareholders while taking consolidated business results and future capital requirements into consideration.

Based on our basic policy, the company had planned to pay 65 yen per share as its fiscal-year end dividend for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2023. However, in light of the steady performance of our consolidated financial forecast for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2023, as announced today, we have decided to increase fiscal-year end dividend by 65 yen per share to 75 yen per share in order to provide an appropriate return of profits to our shareholders. As a result, the Company has revised its annual dividend forecast from 130 yen to 140 yen per share.

The year-end dividend will be discussed at the 75th Ordinary General Meeting of Shareholders scheduled in June 2023.
