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1. Overview of Operating Results, etc.

(1) Overview of Operating Results for the Fiscal Year under Review

The world economy during the consolidated fiscal year under review, although demand for goods was sluggish as stay-at-home demand after the Corona pandemic ran its course, the economy was firm, driven by the service sector, mainly in Europe and the United States. In addition, the Chinese economy experienced owing to lockdowns under the country's zero-COVID policy as well as rapid expansion of infections and subsequent disruption after the lifting of its anti-COVID measures, the normalization of the economy was progressed in the fourth quarter beginning.

Under these economies, each country forging ahead with the policy of monetary tightening in response to accelerating inflation due mainly to higher energy costs, however, the collapse of some banks in the U.S. and Europe at the end of the fiscal year fueled concerns about financial instability.

With regard to the Japanese economy, the normalization of the economy was progressing with the relaxation of anti-infection measures against COVID-19. Although there were some weaknesses in the latter half of the fiscal year, such as production activities and exports has reached the ceiling, personal consumption is recovering and the economy is gradually picking up. Meanwhile, in the foreign exchange market, differences in monetary policy from other countries led to the weaker yen in the third quarter, but the end of the year, the yen appreciated against the U.S. dollar and the situation changed rapidly.

In the electronics market relevant to the Group, demand remained continued sluggish in the Chinese mobile device market, in addition, production adjustments by our customers led to a decrease in demand in the latter half of the fiscal year, we thus faced a harsh business environment. Also in the industrial market, from the latter half of the third quarter, there was a slowdown in semiconductor production equipment and a rapid adjustment in orders for general industrial equipment. Meanwhile in the automotive market, overall car demand was weak due to semiconductor shortages and supply chain disruptions that resulted in output cuts, whereas the market continued to expand in the electrification and electric vehicle (EV)-related fields.

Under these circumstances, the Group aimed to expand orders received and sales by conducting active global marketing centered on its flagship Connector Business and speeding up new product development activities. At the same time, the Group strived to achieve higher business performance by promoting the streamlining of management as a whole, including cost reduction through further expansion of in-house production, improvement in efficiency of equipment, and the curbing of various expenses.

Consequently, for the consolidated fiscal year under review, the Group recorded net sales totaling \\ \text{\figure 235,864} million (105% compared to the previous fiscal year). On the profit side, we posted operating profit totaling \\ \text{\figure 17,562} million (97% compared to the previous fiscal year), ordinary profit totaling \\ \text{\figure 19,115} million (103% compared to the previous fiscal year), and profit attributable to owners of parent totaling \\ \text{\figure 14,639} million (102% compared to the previous fiscal year).

(2) Overview of Financial Position for the Fiscal Year under Review

Total liabilities amounted to ¥55,341 million, marking a decrease of ¥12,113 million from the end of the consolidated fiscal year ended March 31, 2022, due to the payment of trade payables and the scheduled payment of borrowings.

Net assets amounted to ¥171,284 million, marking an increase of ¥13,396 million from the end of the consolidated fiscal year ended March 31, 2022, mainly due to the recording of profit attributable to owners of parent, bringing the equity ratio to 75.5%.

(3) Overview of Cash Flows for the Fiscal Year under Review

Net cash provided by operating activities for the consolidated fiscal year under review was \(\frac{\pmathbf{3}}{3}\)2,451 million (\(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2}\)4,432 million provided in the previous consolidated fiscal year). This was attributable mainly to the recording of profit before income taxes and depreciation and a reduction in inventories.

Net cash used in investing activities was \(\frac{\text{\frac{4}}}{23}\),432 million (\(\frac{\text{\frac{4}}}{20}\),285 million used in the previous consolidated fiscal year), mainly due to expenses arising from the purchase of property, plant and equipment centered on equipment to manufacture new products.

Net cash used in financing activities was ¥11,645 million (¥9,985 million used in the previous consolidated fiscal year), due to the repayment of borrowings and the dividends paid.

As a result, the balance of cash and cash equivalents at the end of the fiscal year under review declined by ¥2,534 million to ¥63,025 million from the previous consolidated fiscal year.

(4) Future Outlook

With regard to the business environment surrounding the Company, in the world, inflation and high interest rates are expected to continue to put downward pressure on the economy, furthermore, the risk of global economic recession is growing due to a concerns about financial instability in the U.S. and European countries and other factors. Thus, the Company believes that the uncertainty over the economic outlook will increase.

With regard to the Japanese economy, despite inflation and a slowdown in overseas economies, the economy is expected to recover gradually, mainly in service consumption.

In the electronics market relevant to the Group, each market it focuses on is expected to grow in the time to come, considering such factors as expanding demand for EVs in the automotive market where we focus on, growing demand for smart factories, and factory automation and robots toward automation, further acceleration in investments in 5G, and full-fledged technical reviews toward 6G in the industrial market, demand for various wearable devices and VR, AR, and other technologies demand is rising against the backdrop of the full-fledged spread of 5G in the mobile device market.

Although this external environment, the Company is expected to remain challenging, owing to the impact of current sluggish demand because of inventory adjustments, as well as rising energy costs and foreign exchange fluctuation risks.

As a result, for the next full consolidated fiscal year, the Group forecasts net sales will amount to \$230,000 million (98% compared to the previous fiscal year), operating profit to \$18,500 million (105% compared to the previous fiscal year), ordinary profit to \$17,500 million (92% compared to the previous fiscal year), and profit attributable to owners of parent to \$13,500 million (92% compared to the previous fiscal year). The aforementioned forecast is based on the exchange rate of \$130 per U.S. dollar.

2. Basic Policy on Selection of Accounting Standards

Taking into consideration the comparability of consolidated financial statements across periods and among companies, the Group will continue to prepare its consolidated financial statements using Japanese GAAP for the time being.

With regard to the application of the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS), the Group's policy is to respond appropriately based on consideration of the situation in Japan and overseas.

Effective the fiscal year under review, "Subsidy income," an item which was listed separately under "Non-operating income" in the previous fiscal year, is included in "Other," as its amount became insignificant. To reflect this change in presentation, items in the consolidated financial statements for the precious fiscal year have been reclassified.

Accordingly, ¥1 million reported for "Subsidy income" and ¥275 million reported for "Other" under "Non-operating income" in the consolidated financial statements for the previous fiscal year have been reclassified as "Other" of ¥277 million.

(Segment information, etc.)

[Segment information]

1. Overview of reportable segments

The Group's reportable segments consist of the three categories of "Connector Business," "User Interface Solutions Business," and "Aerospace Business," based on the classification by usage of our products. The financial information of each reportable segment is available, and the Board of Directors regularly conducts a review for the purpose of making decisions about management resources to be allocated to each segment and assess the segments' performance.

The overview of each reportable segment is as follows.

(Connector Business)

The Connector Business manufactures and sells connectors used in a wide range of fields. These include: products for mobile devices, which center on smartphone components; automotive connectors in infotainment-related applications such as in-vehicle cameras, as well as in body/powertrain areas such as engine ECUs; products for industrial & infrastructure uses such as for machine tools, communications network devices and others; parts for notebook PCs; parts for flat panel televisions.

(User Interface Solutions Business)

The User Interface Solutions Business manufactures and sells products for automobiles, such as automotive capacitive touch panels, and products for industrial and infrastructure uses, such as various types of touch panel monitors and operation panels for industrial machinery and medical equipment.

(Aerospace Business)

The Aerospace Business manufactures and sells electronic equipment for defense and space, such as flight control equipment, inertial navigation systems and radar altimeters, and products for industrial machinery, infrastructure

and automobiles, such as damping and drive equipment for semiconductor manufacturing equipment, sensor packages for oil drilling and automotive rotation angle sensors.

2. Method of calculating net sales, income (loss), assets, and other items by reportable segment

The accounting method for the business segments that are reported is generally the same as the method applied to prepare consolidated financial statements.

Buildings and structures which pertain to more than one segment are not distributed to reportable segments, but are included in adjustment. Meanwhile, related expenses are allocated to each segment.
