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#### 1. Overview of Operating Results, etc.

#### (1) Overview of Operating Results for the Fiscal Year under Review

During the fiscal year ended May 31, 2023, the outlook of the Japanese economy remained uncertain, primarily due to the impacts of the rapid exchange rate fluctuations and Russia's protracted war against Ukraine. In particular, rising energy costs had a significant impact on the Japanese economy as a whole, contributing to increased prices of a variety of goods and services. Consequently, consumers were increasingly budget-minded and the environment surrounding retailers grew even harsher.

It was exactly because of these circumstances that the Group endeavored to make our drugstores "low priced, close and convenient" for consumers by strengthening price competitiveness through pursuing low cost-operations.

As for the Group's store opening strategy, the Group deployed new stores one after another with no concern about stores cannibalizing each other's sales that may result in a temporary decline in profitability. At the same time, the Group also expanded its store networks in new catchment areas. As a result of opening new stores, the number of newly opened stores stood at 37 in Kanto region, 26 in Chubu region, 12 in Kansai region, 12 in Chugoku region, 8 in Shikoku region and 23 in Kyushu region, totaling 118. Furthermore, as 4 stores were closed due to scrap and build, the number of stores at the end of the fiscal year under review became 1,358 in total.

As a result of the above measures, the Group's consolidated operating results for the fiscal year under review were net sales of 827,697 million yen (9.6% increase year-on-year), operating profit of 30,128 million yen (1.1% increase year-on-year), ordinary profit of 33,086 million yen (0.7% increase year-on-year) and profit attributable to owners of parent of 23,797 million yen (2.8% increase year-on-year).

Segment information is omitted because the Group is comprised of a single business segment.

# (2) Overview of Financial Position for the Fiscal Year under Review (Assets)

Current assets at the end of the fiscal year under review increased by 18.7% from the end of the previous fiscal year to 137,085 million yen. This was mainly due to increase in cash and deposits of 8,566 million yen, merchandise of 11,101 million yen, and accounts receivable - other of 1,390 million yen.

Non-current assets increased by 14.7% from the end of the previous fiscal to 283,881 million yen partly due to acquisition of property, plant and equipment including buildings and structures and land.

As a result, total assets increased by 16.0% from the end of the previous fiscal year to 420,967 million yen.

#### (Liabilities)

Current liabilities at the end of the fiscal year under review increased by 18.5% from the end of the previous fiscal year to 192,053 million yen. This was mainly due to increase in accounts payable - trade of 22,627 million yen, short-term borrowings of 1,353 million yen, accounts payable - other of 3,273 million yen, accrued expenses of 1,038 million yen, and accrued consumption taxes of 1,022 million yen.

Non-current liabilities increased by 70.2% from the end of the previous fiscal year to 17,842 million yen mainly due to an increase in long-term borrowings of 7,018 million yen.

As a result, total liabilities increased by 21.6% from the end of the previous fiscal year to 209,895 million yen.

#### (Net assets)

Total net assets increased by 10.8% from the end of the previous fiscal year to 211,072 million yen mainly due to an increase in retained earnings of 20,530 million yen.

#### (3) Overview of Cash Flows for the Fiscal Year under Review

The balance of cash and cash equivalents (hereinafter "cash") at the end of the fiscal year under review increased by 8,566 million yen or 22.9% from the end of previous fiscal year to 45,928 million yen.

The status of consolidated cash flows for the fiscal year under review and contributing factors were as follows.

### (Cash Flows from Operating Activities)

Net cash provided by operating activities amounted to 54,434 million yen (up 69.1% year-on-year).

This was mainly due to positive factors such as profit before income taxes of 32,773 million yen, depreciation of 17,368 million yen and an increase in trade payables of 22,627 million yen, and negative factors such as increase in inventories of 11,156 million yen and income taxes paid of 9,111 million yen.

#### (Cash Flows from Investing Activities)

Net cash used in investing activities amounted to 49,113 million yen (up 12.3% year-on-year).

This was mainly due to purchase of property, plant and equipment of 46,636 million yen and payments of leasehold and guarantee deposits of 1,834 million yen.

(Cash Flows from Financing Activities)

Net cash provided by financing activities amounted to 3,245 million yen (an increase of 9,467 million yen from a year earlier).

This was mainly due to income from long-term borrowings of 10,000 million yen, repayments of long-term borrowings of 1,628 million yen, dividends paid of 3,266 million yen and repayments of finance lease liabilities of 1,858 million yen.

#### (4) Future Outlook

As for future prospects during the fiscal year ending May 31, 2024, inflation is expected to continue to drive up the prices of various goods, and consumer confidence is anticipated to weaken. It is exactly because of these circumstances that the Company is determined to further refine low cost-operations and continue to strengthen efforts so that the Company can make sales of "products of high quality and available at the lowest prices possible."

The Company intends to conduct store opening during the fiscal year ending May 31, 2024, based on our dominant strategy with no concern about stores cannibalizing each other's sales. The Company plans to deploy stores in the new catchment-areas of Kanto, Chubu and Kansai regions while continuing to open new stores in Chugoku, Shikoku and Kyushu regions.

With the above measures, the Company's forecast for its consolidated financial results for the fiscal year ending May 31, 2024, are net sales of 916,000 million yen, operating profit of 30,200 million yen, ordinary profit of 33,200 million yen and profit attributable to owners of parent of 23,800 million yen.

# (5) Basic Policy on Distribution of Profits and Dividends for the Fiscal Year under Review and the Next Fiscal Year

The Company's basic policy on distribution of profits is to return profits through stable and sustained dividend to shareholders as well as secure sufficient internal reserves for the reinforcement of its management structure and utilize the reserves for appropriate reinvestments.

In accordance with the above policy, the Company has decided on an interim dividend of 42.5 yen and a year-end dividend of 57.5 yen per share for the fiscal year ended May 31, 2023. Accordingly, the annual dividend

will be 100 yen per share as an ordinary dividend, an increase of 20 yen from a year earlier.

The Company also plans to make an interim dividend of 60 yen and a year-end dividend of 60 yen per share for the fiscal year ending May 31, 2024. Accordingly, the annual dividend is planned to be 120 yen per share as an ordinary dividend, an increase of 20 yen from a year earlier.

#### 2. Basic Policy on Selection of Accounting Standards

The Group plans to continue to prepare its consolidated financial statements under the Japanese GAAP for the time being as the Group has been currently developing its business in Japan.

With regard to the adoption of the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS), the Group will continue to make its deliberation in consideration of factors such as future business development and domestic and international trends.
