(2) Reason for the announcement

The recovery of the market price for ferroalloys is expected to be slower and decline even further than anticipated since the third quarter. As a result, the Company anticipate an increase in the share of loss of entities accounted for using the equity method due to the expansion of the decline in profit of overseas equity-method affiliates. As a result of the above reasons, the Company has revised our forecast for ordinary profit announced on May 11, 2023. On the other hand, the Company has not changed our forecast for net sales, which aren't affected by fluctuations in the share of loss of entities accounted for using the equity method. Likewise, our forecast for the current profit attributable to owners of the parent remains unchanged, as the impact of the revision of ordinary profit is expected to be minor due to factors such as an increase in deferred tax assets.

Our exchange rate assumption, which is a premise of the outlook for the next fiscal year, is ¥140/US\$. Based on this exchange rate assumption, the Group's financial results forecast for the next fiscal year is shown above.

(Note) The aforementioned financial results forecasts have been prepared based on information available to the Company as of the date on which this document was released. Consequently, actual results may vary with respect to the forecast amounts due to various unforeseen factors.
