Notice Regarding Basic Agreement on Capital and Business Alliance
With INTLOOP Inc. and AMIFIABLE CO., Ltd.

Simplex Holdings, Inc. (Head Office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director, President and CEO: Hideki Kaneko; hereinafter “Simplex Holdings”) hereby announces that Simplex Inc. (Head Office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; CEO: Hideki Kaneko; hereinafter “Simplex”), one of its subsidiaries, has entered into the basic agreement on capital and business alliance with INTLOOP Inc. (Head Office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director: Hirofumi Hayashi; hereinafter “INTLOOP”) and AMIFIABLE CO., Ltd. (Head Office: Meguro-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and CEO: Ryuichi Kawamura; hereinafter “AMIFIABLE”).

1. Purpose of Capital and Business Alliance

By introducing MLET.II, an AI-based automated testing tool, which is a mainstay product for AMIFIABLE, Simplex is able to automate the preparation and implementation of testing based on design specifications and ultimately improve the productivity and quality of a testing process which is part of development operations. In addition to improving the efficiency of a testing process with MLET.II, the three parties will bring together the technical elements and human resources in the field of AI of Simplex and INTLOOP to automate their development operations based on design specifications and significantly streamline their overall system development operations. They also aim to expand into new domains in their respective business segments by leveraging their combined customer base.

2. Details of Capital and Business Alliance

(1) Collaboration toward building a new software development model using AI

Simplex and INTLOOP will leverage their human resources in the field of AI to support the additional development of peripheral and other functions for MLET.II developed by AMIFIABLE, as well as assess the feasibility of automating development operations.

(2) Investment in AMIFIABLE

Simplex and INTLOOP will make a minority investment of approximately ¥200 million each in AMIFIABLE.
