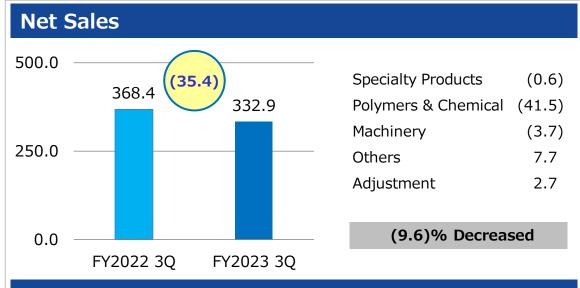

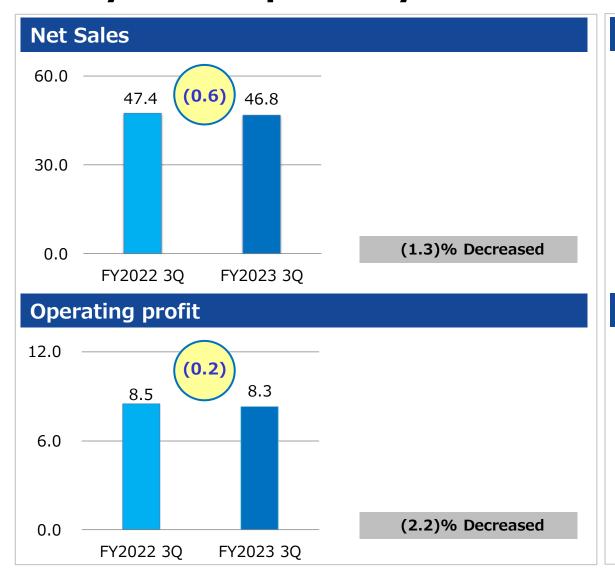

• Weak performance of polyimide and other products despite strong performance of separation membranes and ceramics

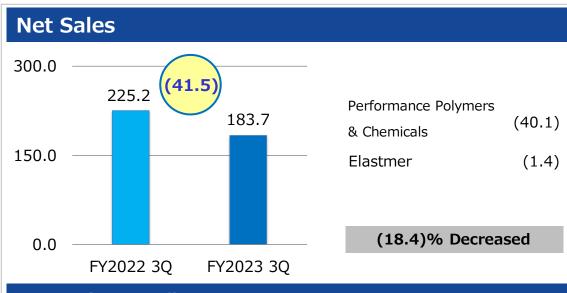

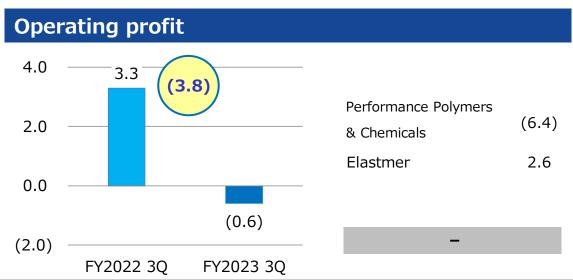

Qualitative Information

Net sales: Down

- Nylon polymers: Decreased sales volume in the first half despite the recovery trend of demand for food packaging film
- Caprolactam & ammonium sulfate: Decreased sales volume due to declining demand and lower sales prices due to decline in raw materials prices
- Fine chemicals: Lower sales prices resulted from market price fallings of the products and decreased sales volume due to declining demand

- Lower prices of raw materials in steel products business

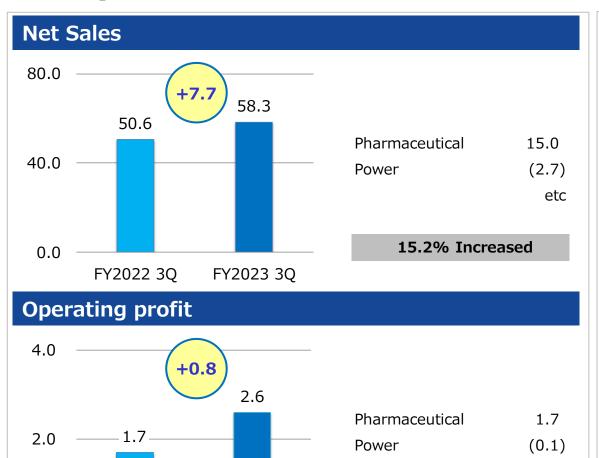

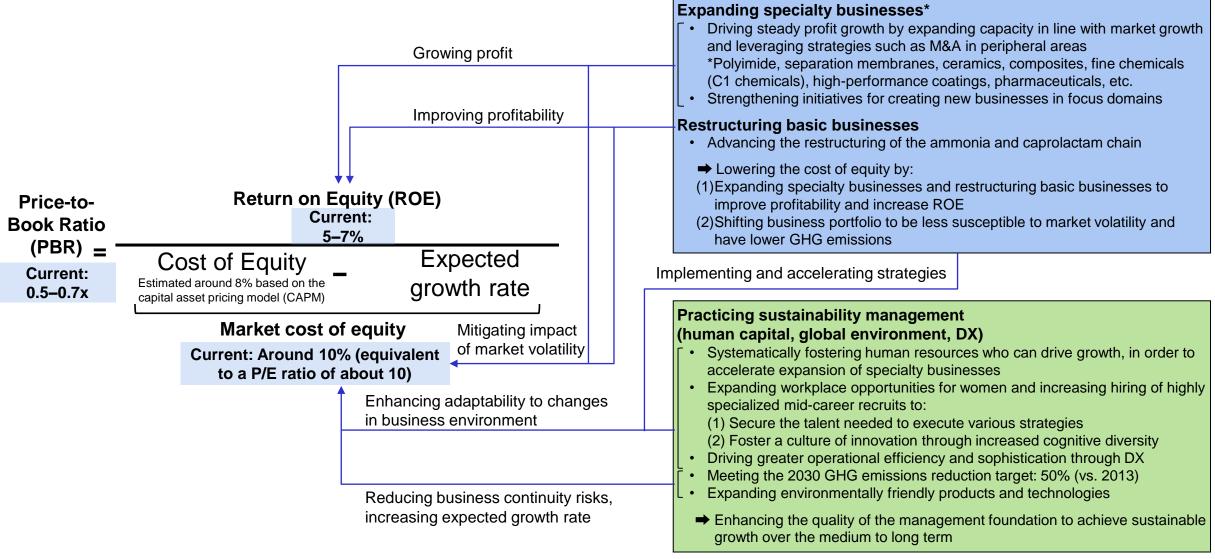

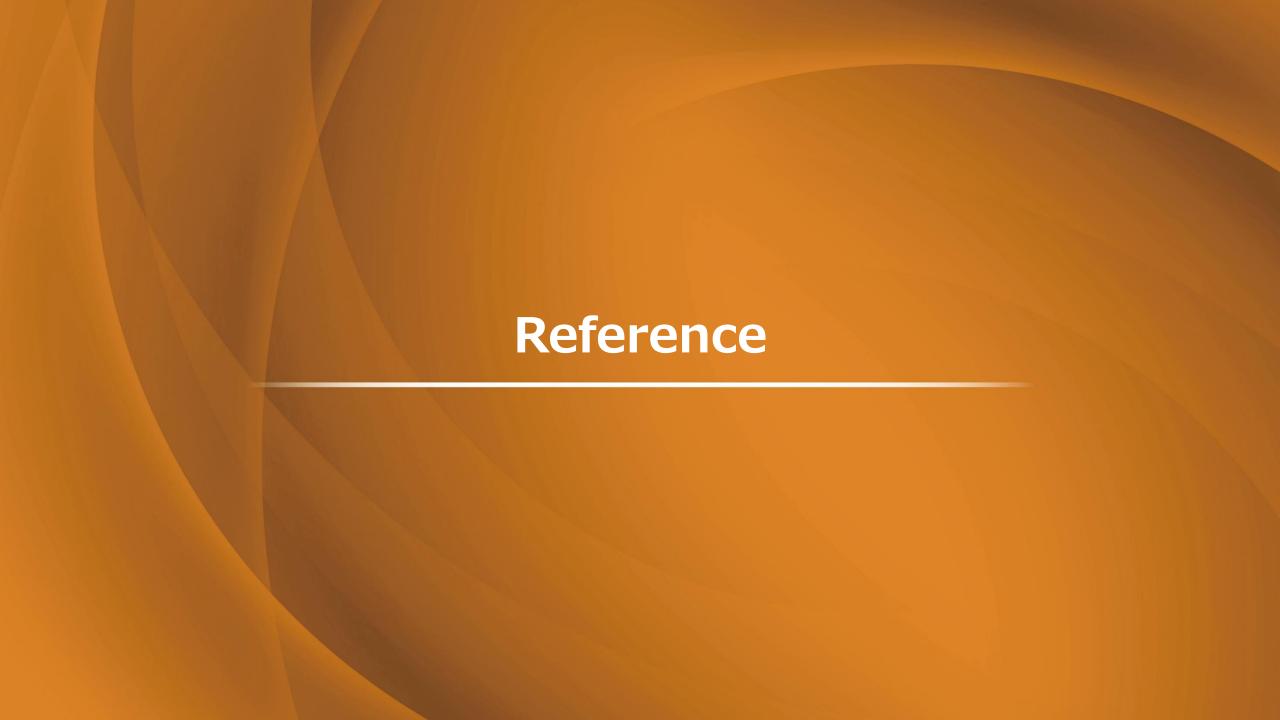

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- The domestic cement business achieved profitability in FY2023 1Q-3Q thanks to the effects of improvements such as the completion of a 5,000-yen price hike and increased use of low-cost thermal energy. Although the business environment remains challenging due to declining domestic demand and rising logistics costs, the company aims to return to profitability for the full year.
- The environment and energy business and domestic group companies posted increased profits in the FY2023 1Q-3Q following the 1st half.
- In the U.S. business, ready-mixed concrete demand was strong in the first half of FY2023, but a decline in demand for commercial facilities and bad weather condition affected the growth in ready-mixed concrete sales in FY2023 3Q. However, the effect of price hikes led to a significant increase in profit for FY2023 1Q-3Q. In FY2023 4Q, the profit margin is expected to decrease due to sluggish sales volume and higher costs.
- In FY2023 3Q, the estimated additional cost for dismantling the Aomori plant, which was shut down at the end of FY2022, was recorded as an extraordinary loss.
