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1. Overview of Operating Results, etc.

(1) Overview of Operating Results for the Fiscal Year under Review

During the fiscal year under review, the outlook for the Japanese economy remained uncertain as consumer confidence declined due to factors such as rising resource prices and sharp exchange rate fluctuations, despite a recovery in economic activity against the backdrop of easing of behavioral restrictions due to the COVID-19 epidemic.

In terms of the current situation of marine transport, cargo movement continues to be sluggish due to factors such as the global economic recession, and the business conditions remain tough as ocean freight rates have declined due to the normalization of the supply and demand balance.

Under such circumstances, based on the basic policy of the 5th Medium-term Management Plan (January 2023 to December 2027), for which the fiscal year under review is the first year, the Group has stepped up efforts to achieve further growth as a comprehensive international freight forwarder with the slogan "Aiming to be the best solution provider in international logistics."

However, the effects of global trade contraction, including the slowdown of the Chinese economy, have been significant, and the Group's financial results were lower than the previous year due to falling freight rates and a decrease in the volume of freight handled.

Consequently, for the fiscal year under review, the Company posted net sales of \(\pm\)32,280 million (down 31.8% year on year), operating profit of \(\pm\)4,203 million (down 37.1% year on year), ordinary profit of \(\pm\)4,446 million (down 35.3% year on year), and profit attributable to owners of parent of \(\pm\)3,041 million (down 34.6% year on year), showing a year-on-year decrease in net sales and profit.

Operating results by segment are as follows.

1) Japan

Export consolidation cargo services are the mainstay of the international freight transportation business in Japan. In the fiscal year under review, net sales and profit on a non-consolidated basis decreased due to the impact of a fall in freight rates to the pre-COVID-19 level with the port disruptions ending around 2022, as well as a significant drop in the volume of consolidated cargo handled as a result of such factors as the consolidated cargo, which had shifted away from full container load in recent years, returning to full container load.

Among domestic subsidiaries, UCI Airfreight Japan, Inc. posted lower net sales and profit due to a decline in freight rates in mainstay air transportation. Moreover, despite lower net sales due to a decline in freight rates, etc., Flying Fish Inc. recorded a year-on-year increase in gross profit as a result of its efforts to secure profits. However, its selling, general and administrative expenses increased due to investments in new systems, etc., leading to a year-on-year decrease in operating profit.

As a result, net sales of the Japan segment decreased by ¥13,103 million (36.9%) year on year to ¥22,381 million, and segment profit (operating profit) also decreased by ¥1,765 million (37.5%) year on year to ¥2,946 million.

2) Overseas

The Group has 11 consolidated subsidiaries in Asia and the United States. In recent years, these subsidiaries have been working to strengthen and advance services other than those to and from Japan. During the fiscal year under review, however, both net sales and profit decreased due to lower freight rates and a decrease in consolidation cargo from Japan, which accounts for the greater part of freight handled by overseas subsidiaries.

As a result, net sales of the Overseas segment decreased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{\frac{4}}}{1,936}\) million (16.4%) year on year to \(\frac{\pmathbf{\frac{4}}}{9,898}\) million, and segment profit (operating profit) also decreased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{\frac{4}}}{11}\) million (36.1%) year on year to \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{1,259}\) million.

(2) Overview of Financial Position for the Fiscal Year under Review

Total assets amounted to \(\frac{\pmathbf{x}}{23,362}\) million, up \(\frac{\pmathbf{x}}{1,229}\) million from the end of the previous fiscal year. The main reason for the change is an increase of \(\frac{\pmathbf{x}}{2,080}\) million in buildings and structures due in part to the acquisition of a warehouse in South Korea, despite a decrease of \(\frac{\pmathbf{x}}{787}\) million in accounts receivable - trade.

Total liabilities amounted to \$2,981 million, down \$1,642 million from the end of the previous fiscal year. The main reasons for the change are decreases of \$1,186 million in income taxes payable and \$287 million in accounts payable - trade.

In addition, net assets amounted to ¥20,381 million, up ¥2,871 million from the end of the previous fiscal year. The main reasons for the change are increases of ¥2,112 million in retained earnings and ¥686 million in foreign currency translation adjustment.

(3) Overview of Cash Flows for the Fiscal Year under Review

Cash and cash equivalents at the end of the fiscal year under review amounted to \\$13,885 million, down \\$408 million from the end of the previous fiscal year. The overview of cash flows is as follows.

(Cash Flows from Operating Activities)

Net cash provided by operating activities was \(\frac{\pmathbf{\pmathbf{2}}}{2,644}\) million (\(\frac{\pmathbf{\pmathbf{5}}}{5,968}\) million was provided in the previous fiscal year). The main cash inflows include \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{4,454}\) million in profit before income taxes. The main cash outflows include \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2,381}\) million in income taxes paid.

(Cash Flows from Investing Activities)

Net cash used in investing activities was \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2}\),460 million (\(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{18}\) million was used in the previous fiscal year). The main cash outflows include \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2}\),461 million in purchase of property, plant and equipment due in part to the acquisition of a warehouse in South Korea. The main cash inflows include \(\frac{\pmathbf{5}}{5}\) million of proceeds from sale of investment securities.

(Cash Flows from Financing Activities)

Net cash used in financing activities was \(\xi\)1,164 million (\(\xi\)707 million was used in the previous fiscal year). The main cash outflows include \(\xi\)928 million in dividends paid and \(\xi\)147 million in repayments of lease liabilities.

(4) Future Outlook

Regarding the future outlook, the external environment is expected to remain uncertain due mainly to the unstable global situation caused by the situation in Ukraine and the conflict in the Middle East, the effects of persistently high prices due to inflation, and the uncertain future of the economy. On the other hand, the efficient sales system based on the formation of organizational structure that the Group has been working on since last year has gradually begun to show results, and the volume of mainstay single consolidation cargo handled is expected to increase. In addition, regarding the forwarding business, which has been positioned as the Group's second core business, the Company is expanding transactions centered on the specialized department at the Osaka Head Office. Moreover, both UCI Airfreight Japan, Inc. and Flying Fish Inc., whose cargo handling has been increasing since the second half of 2023, are expected to further expand their forwarding transactions in fiscal 2024 and contribute to the Group's performance.

Overseas, NAIGAI BUSAN LOGISTICS CENTER, the Company's subsidiary in South Korea, acquired a logistics warehouse last year, and by further deepening and revitalizing collaboration within the Group, including in the warehouse business, the Group's performance is expected to return to growth from the second half of 2024 onwards.

Regarding the 5th Medium-term Management Plan, organizational structure and personnel system reforms began in the first year of the plan, and going forward, the Company will aim to enhance corporate value by increasing sales and profit to achieve the planned targets.

Based on the above, the Group projects its full-year earnings for the next fiscal year (the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024) as follows: net sales of \(\frac{\pmathbf{x}}{34,000}\) million (up 5.3% year on year), operating profit of \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{4,600}\) million (up 9.4% year on year), ordinary profit of \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{4,800}\) million (up 7.9% year on year), and profit attributable to owners of parent of \(\frac{\pmathbf{3}}{3,300}\) million (up 8.5% year on year).

In addition, the Group regards the return of profits to shareholders as one of its management priorities, and hopes to maintain a continuous and stable dividend payout into the future while comprehensively taking into account its business performance and financial conditions.

Based on the above policy, the Group plans to pay an interim dividend of ¥40 and a year-end dividend of ¥45 for the fiscal year under review, resulting in an annual dividend of ¥85. The Group intends to maintain the annual dividend of ¥85 for the next fiscal year.

2. Basic Policy on Selection of Accounting Standards

The Group's policy is to prepare its consolidated financial statements in accordance with Japanese GAAP for the time being, taking into consideration comparability of consolidated financial statements between periods and between companies.

The Group intends to respond appropriately to the adoption of the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) considering circumstances in Japan and overseas.

- 1. Overview of reportable segments
 - (1) Method of determining reportable segments

The Group's reportable segments consist of organizational units of the Company for which separate financial statements are available and which are regularly reviewed by top managerial decision-making body to determine the allocation of management resources and assess business performance.

The Group is engaged in international freight transportation business and ancillary services. The Japanese business is mainly operated by the Company, UCI Airfreight Japan, Inc., and Flying Fish Inc., and the overseas business is operated by local subsidiaries in China, South Korea, Hong Kong, Singapore, Thailand, Indonesia, India, and the United States.

Each local subsidiary is an independent business unit that formulates strategies and conducts business activities in each region, while the Company oversees all overarching management policies for the Group and gives instructions to each local subsidiary.

Therefore, the Group is composed of regional segments based on overarching strategies for each region, and has two reportable segments, Japan and Overseas.

Japan: NAIGAI TRANS LINE LTD., UCI Airfreight Japan, Inc., and Flying Fish Inc. (3 companies

in total)

Overseas: 2 local subsidiaries in China, 3 local subsidiaries in South Korea, 1 local subsidiary each in

total)
