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## Announcement of Commencement of Production from the Knarr Oil Field in the Norwegian North Sea

Idemitsu Kosan Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and CEO: Takashi Tsukioka) is pleased to announce that its subsidiary, Idemitsu Snorre Oil Development Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; President: Kosuke Tsuji)\*1 has started commercial production from the Knarr oil field in the Norwegian North Sea on March 16, 2015 through its Norwegian subsidiary Idemitsu Petroleum Norge AS (Managing Director: Teruyuki Takahashi).

## 1. Outline of Knarr Oil Field

The Knarr oil field is located in approximately 55 km north east of the Snorre oil field, which we have 9.6% share, and the water depth is approximately 410m. The Petrojarl Knarr FPSO (Floating Production, Storage and Offloading) is moored near the field as the production facility.


The recoverable reserves of Knarr oil field is approximately 80 million barrel oil equivalent and the Idemitsu's portion is about 20 million barrel oil equivalent.
