Japan System Techniques Co., Ltd. (JAST) and consolidated subsidiary JASTEC (THAILAND) CO., LTD. signed a cooperation agreement on October 26, 2016 with Thai-Nichi Institute of Technology, a university located in Bangkok, Thailand. Under this agreement, the university will send students to work as interns at JAST and JAST and the university will share information involving data management systems.

1. Summary of the Agreement and Purpose

Thai-Nichi Institute of Technology will send students as interns to JAST in Japan for training. In addition, cooperation will include the sharing of information concerning this university's data management system and the provision to the university of JAST's GAKUEN school operations reform package.

JAST expects this agreement to create more opportunities in Thailand for the JAST Group to receive orders from universities and other organizations. JAST also views this as the first step toward establishing a base for growth throughout the ASEAN region. Furthermore, providing training to interns who are Thai-Nichi Institute of Technology students will contribute to friendship between Japan and Thailand. The interns will gain a good understanding of Japanese culture and customs and this program will help JAST recruit well-trained individuals.
