Started Sales of "au Life Insurance" with Refunds

TOKYO, January 11, 2017 – LIFENET INSURANCE COMPANY (TSE Mothers 7157, President Daisuke Iwase, URL: http://ir.lifenet-seimei.co.jp/en/) announces the monthly business performance for December 2016.

Annualized premium^{*1} of new business in the month of December 2016 was 114 million yen (100% of December 2015). The number of applications was 3,180 (112% of December 2015), with the number of new business at 2,553 (106% of December 2015). Accordingly, annualized premium^{*1} of policies-in-force was 9,856 million yen. The number of policies-in-force as of the end of December 2016 resulted in a total of 234,841, and sum insured of policies-in-force stands at 1,948,424 million yen.

In December 2016, insurance premiums and claims and benefits recorded 814 million yen (107% of December 2015) and 126 million yen (176% of December 2015), respectively. Lifenet renewed "au Life Insurance" and started sales of "au Life Insurance" with Refunds through KDDI CORPORATION on December 1, 2016. Furthermore, by adding new product of "au Long-term Disability Insurance," Lifenet offered four products of "au Life Insurance" with Refunds.
