



## **Japan Display Inc. Comment on Media Reports**

TOKYO, Japan, October 4, 2017 – Today some media are reporting on plans by Japan Display Inc. ("JDI") to seek partners in regard to mass production of organic light-emitting diode (OLED) displays, plans by JDI's equity-method affiliate JOLED to procure funds and other planning issues.

JDI wishes to make clear it has not made any announcement about any of these matters.

As indicated in a JDI news release titled "Structural Reform & Outline of Medium-Term Management" issued on August 9 of this year, JDI is seeking to partner with a global company in OLED development and mass production.

Also, JOLED and JDI continue to hold discussions that include possible use of JDI's Nomi Plant to mass produce JOLED products.

Once a decision is made about a business matter requiring disclosure, JDI will release information accordingly.
