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1. Quarterly Business Results

(1) Results of operations

During the second quarter cumulative period (April 1, 2018 to September 30, 2018) of fiscal 2018 (ending March 31, 2019), the global economy was favorable overall, despite continued concerns about the outlook for the future, such as the impact from the trade policies of the U.S. and China. The business environment for the Company remained steady, with continued strong growth in private sector capital investment and infrastructure-related demand in both Japan and the U.S., and sustained firm demand in China, despite lingering concerns over a slowdown in capital investment.

Fiscal 2018 is the third year of the Company's five-year Mid Term Plan, during which the Company will transition from a platform enhancement to a full-fledged growth phase. During the period under review, while steadily capturing robust investment demand, the Company moves to the next phase by implementing various measures.

The Company continued to increase production capacity during the subject second quarter period, due to the robust demand that has continued from the previous fiscal year. As a result, consolidated net sales rose 14.3% from the same period of the previous fiscal year, to $\pm 28,190$ million. Earnings rose sharply in all categories, supported by favorable sales. Operating income amounted to $\pm 2,564$ million (an increase of 102.0%), with ordinary income of $\pm 2,314$ million (an increase of 163.2%) and net income attributable to owners of the parent of $\pm 1,835$ million (an increase of 244.7%).

Japan

Demand remained robust for infrastructure-related investments and private-sector capital expenditures in both the domestic and export markets. As a result, net sales in Japan amounted to ¥14,416 million (an increase of 35.4% from the same period of the previous fiscal year), with operating income of ¥3,177 million (an increase of 85.8%). The significant increase in revenue and earnings was due in part to full-scale renewal of its IT infrastructure in the same period of the previous fiscal year, and a subsequent temporary decline in production activities.

The Americas

The U.S. economy, despite concerns about the impact from trade friction with China, was marked by firm demand for natural resource-related and other investment from the private sector, and public facilities investment. As a result, net sales in the Americas amounted to ¥12,942 million (an increase of 9.5% from the same period of the previous fiscal year), with operating income of ¥377 million (an increase of 41.6%).

China

The Chinese market, despite a sense of uncertainty about the future due to trade friction with the U.S., was marked by firm domestic demand in growth industries, centered on EVs. As a result of the Company's capturing this demand, net sales in China amounted to ¥3,679 million (an increase of 21.0% from the same period of the previous fiscal year), with operating income of ¥476 million (an increase of 39.2%).

Asia (excluding Japan and China)

The Company captured robust demand in Asia overall, with performance boosted by large-scale projects that have continued from the previous fiscal year. Net sales in Asia amounted to ¥2,295 million (an increase of 20.4% from the same period of the previous fiscal year), with operating income of ¥283 million (an increase of 214.2%).

Europe

The Company continued its proactive measures from the beginning of the term to promote sales, in order to capture the rising capital investment demand in the region overall. As a result, net sales amounted to ¥1,269 million (an increase of 35.6% from the same period of the previous fiscal year), with operating income of ¥10 million (compared to an operating loss of ¥22 million in the previous fiscal year).

Others

This segment currently comprises the Australia business. Net sales amounted to ¥1,019 million (an increase of 3.0% from the same period of the previous fiscal year), with operating income of ¥17 million (compared to an operating loss of ¥46 million in the previous fiscal year).

(2) Financial Position

1. Assets, liabilities, and net assets

Assets

Total assets amounted to ¥62,392 million, an increase of ¥537 million compared to the end of the previous fiscal year. The main factors were a ¥1,902 million decrease in cash and deposits; a ¥1,857 million increase in merchandise and finished goods; and a ¥495 million increase in raw materials and supplies.

Liabilities

Total liabilities amounted to ¥37,081 million, a decrease of ¥1,076 million compared to the end of the previous fiscal year. The main factors were a ¥1,472 million increase in short-term loans payable; a ¥796 million decrease in accrued expenses; and a ¥1,149 million decrease in long-term loans payable.

Net Assets

Net assets amounted to ¥25,310 million, an increase of ¥1,613 million compared to the end of the previous fiscal year. The main factors were a ¥1,367 million increase in retained earnings; and a ¥270 million increase in foreign currency translation adjustment.

2. Cash Flows

Cash and cash equivalents amounted to ¥8,865 million, a decrease of ¥1,904 million compared with the end of the previous fiscal year.

Cash Flows from Operating Activities

Net cash provided by operating activities amounted to ¥53 million, a decrease of ¥2,899 million compared to the previous fiscal year. The main factors were ¥2,314 million in income before income taxes; ¥1,177 million in depreciation and amortization; ¥1,593 million in changes in inventories; and ¥928 million in income taxes paid.

Cash Flows from Investing Activities

Net cash used in investing activities amounted to ¥1,091 million, an increase of ¥222 million compared to the previous fiscal year. The main factors were ¥532 million in payments for the acquisition of property and equipment; and ¥90 million in payments for the acquisition of intangible fixed assets.

Cash Flows from Financing Activities

Net cash used in financing activities amounted to ¥798 million, a decrease of ¥959 million compared to the previous fiscal year. The main factors were ¥1,408 million in net increase in short-term loans payable; and ¥2,138 million in repayments of long-term loans payable.
