Santen Pharmaceutical Selected as Title Sponsor of IBSA Blind Football World Grand Prix 2020!

— New tournament name decided as the Santen IBSA Blind Football[®] World Grand Prix 2020 in Shinagawa, with 8 participating national teams. Draw also announced with Japan in Group A! —



Santen Pharmaceutical Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Osaka; Chairman and CEO: Akira Kurokawa; hereinafter, "Santen") and the Japan Blind Football Association (Shinjuku-ku, Tokyo; Chief Director: Shiro Shiojima; hereinafter, "JBFA") today held a press conference to announce that Santen has been selected as the title sponsor of the IBSA Blind Football World Grand Prix 2020 (in Tennozu Park, Shinagawa-ku, Tokyo) to be held from Monday, March 16 to Saturday, March 21, 2020. On the same day, national teams participating in the World Grand Prix were announced and the draw was held. The name of the tournament has been changed accordingly, and the new name will be " the Santen IBSA Blind Football World Grand Prix 2020 in Shinagawa ".

In addition to japan, it was announced that the participating countries were announced and a draw was held. 8 countries including Argentina (Ranked No. 1 in the World Ranking), Brazil (Ranked No.2), China

(Ranked No.3), Spain (Ranked No.5), France (Ranked No.11), Thailand (Ranked No.15), Germany (Ranked No.20) and Japan (Ranked No.13) announced that they will participate. Among the countries coming to Japan this time, 5 countries other than Thailand and Germany and have the right to participate in the Tokyo 2020 Paralympics. As a result of the draw, Japan will be in Group A.

In the briefing of this year's World Brand Prix at the beginning of the press conference, it was announced that; Santen has been selected as the event's title sponsor, and that the event would bear a new name. As a specialized ophthalmic company, Santen resonated with the JBFA's vision and mission and concluded a partnership agreement with the JBFA in March 2017. Since then, Santen has sponsored the Japanese national men's and women's blind football teams and supported events organized by the JBFA to provide children with visual impairments with opportunities to participate in sports. Santen President and COO Shigeo Taniuchi expressed his enthusiasm and expectations for the company's subsequent collaboration with the JBFA as follows: "I am very honored and glad that Santen can be the title sponsor of the IBSA Blind Football World Grand Prix 2020. I hope that the JBFA and Santen unite their assets and strengths to further accelerate their efforts in Japan and the rest of the world to promote blind football, increase public understanding of disabilities and impairments, enhance the quality of life of people with visual impairments, and mitigate or eliminate visual impairments through medical treatment."



In the following draw, with the cooperation of the speakers, Japan were divided into Group A, and France which is the same pod as Japan, were divided into Group B so that the participating teams from the same region would not be biased. Group A, the same as Japan, will be Argentina, China, Germany, and Group B will be Brazil, Spain, France, and Thailand. The 2nd place teams in each group will advance to the semifinals on the 20th, and the final, the 3rd place match and the ranking match will be held on 21st (Last Day) to decide the final ranking.
