## Announcement on the Launch of CPResQ the Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Aid

We are pleased to announce that we have launched CPResQ, a Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Aid, on April 1. This product is internally designed and developed based on our experience handling AEDs (Automated External Defibrillators) to help support the proper implementation of chest compressions for cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

Since 2015, we have been selling AEDs branded as Cardiac ResQ series. This line of products was developed to pursue easy-to-use functions based on our longtime experience in the cardiovascular space through sales of cardiac pacemakers and other related devices. A wide range of customers have adopted our AEDs up to date. In general, AEDs are widely available at public facilities and are easy to handle in life-saving situations even for non-specially trained lay people.

According to Japan Resuscitation Council's guideline published in 2015, it is extremely important to conduct appropriate chest compressions together with defibrillation (electrical shock) by AEDs to effectively perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation to increase the survival rate. However, it is difficult for the untrained public to perform chest compressions correctly in emergency situations with proper depths (approximately 5cm but not more than 6cm) and constant tempo (100-120 times per minute).

CPResQ is a medical device that helps conduct appropriate chest compressions for patients in the state of cardiopulmonary arrest to recover the normal state. When placed on the patient's chest, it gives off a sound at certain intervals to let users know the appropriate rhythms to perform chest compressions. In addition, it can measure the frequency and depths of chest compressions in real time, so that its indicators and voice can give feedback to the user on whether appropriate chest compressions are being performed.

This product can be used by the general public as well after taking a simple course. Not only for real life-saving situations, can it be also used for training. With help of the dedicated PC software, users can check the quality of chest compressions visually, and thus we expect it will contribute to improve chest compression techniques greatly.

We will continue to create an environment in which people can live safe and sound by providing superior products that can be easily used by the general public as well as highly specialized devices for healthcare professionals.
