We would like to express our sincere sympathy to those who have been influenced by the novel coronavirus infection (COVID-19).

freee K.K. ("freee") announced on "Announcement regarding Impacts of the Novel Coronavirus on Business Results" on March 24, 2020, that we had decided to continue our work-from-home policy beyond March 31, 2020, in order to prevent further spread of the new virus infection and ensure the safety of our employees and stakeholders.

Later, the state-of-emergency declaration of the Japanese government was lifted throughout Japan on May 25, 2020 and, in response, freee K.K. have decided that we permit our employees to come to the offices and visit business partners on a limited scale and an as-needed basis starting on June 1, 2020, while maintaining the work-from-home policy in principle.
